

























# FREEDOM OF THE PRESS?

Tax to Kill	and 2018		The Stamp Act of 1765 taxed paper, the burden fell on printers who mostly supported the Patriots. All newspapers were party driven. Loyalists papers shut down or moved to NYC.

Who Said we get free press rights?			George Mason was one of three attendees of the closed door Constitutional Convention along with Edmund Randolph and Elbridge Gerry who REFUSED to sign ratification of the new 'constitution' without a Bill of Rights and an end to the Slave trade. He fought for both again in 1787 led Madison to finally introduce a Bill of rights in 1789.

	<b>John Adams</b>	<b>Thomas Jefferson</b>	
			
Our 1st Police State Starts	and 1800		President Adams solely restricted freedom of speech and the press. Adams, a Federalist, signed into law the Alien and Sedition Act of 1798 which were four bills passed by the Federalist-dominated 5th United States Congress. They made it harder for an immigrant to become a citizen (Naturalization Act), allowed the president to imprison and deport non-citizens who were deemed dangerous (Alien Friends Act of 1798) and criminalized making false statements that were critical of the federal government (Sedition Act of 1798). This was to stop criticism of any type against the Federal Government. You can see how this false government fear inciting and limiting of liberty rights (they ignored the Bill of Rights, what the Federalists acquiesced to so the States would Ratify the Constitution. The Federalists caught us all in their endless web of false promises), all led to the terrible internment camps in America of Japanese and Asian citizens during World War 2 and endless runaway government we have today.

Fascism in the Press put down			Senator McCarthy used a second Red Scare (falsely accusing many in government of being Communist) to pit one political party against the other in America. If allowed to proceed one party would be destroyed and this country could not endure a one party system. McCarthy was trying to end American democracy using lies, accusations and rumor to discredit honest people and exploit fear of communism. Only one man, Edward R. Murrow was brave enough to take him on and take him down in a high point of American Journalism.
	<b>Daniel Ellsberg in 1971</b>	<b>Nixon in 1971</b>	
			
2nd Police State Averted			Mr. Ellsberg, a citizen activist, uncovered crimes against the American people while working for the government. For 30 years the government had been lying to the American people fighting a false un-winnable war in Vietnam, wasting 50,000 U.S. servicemen's lives, destroying the lives of their families, and sending billions of dollars ravaging all of Southeast Asia for no good reason other than they didn't want to lose a war. Ellsberg took The Pentagon Papers, a detailed internal review of the war's decision making, to the New York Times paper, then to the Washington Post for publication. Ellsberg's actions led to the end of the Vietnam War and Richard Nixon. After a vigorous defense, Ellsberg did not serve prison time due in part to the Supreme Court 6-3 ruling dismissing the White House Court injunction to stop publishing of the Pentagon Papers.

			The Federal Radio Commission (1926-34) was created to regulate radio use "as the public interest, convenience, or necessity" requires. The Radio Act of 1927 superseded the Radio Act of 1912, which had given regulatory powers over radio communication to the Secretary of Commerce and Labor. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is an independent agency of the United States government to regulate interstate communications by radio, television, wire, satellite, and cable. In 1934 the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) replaced the functions of the Federal Radio Commission. All these agencies were supposed to regulate fair use of public communication modes to promote useful information and quality of information for the American citizen. They were supposed to be politically impartial. But today in 2018 they are far from that. The SEC (Security and Exchange Commission) was supposed to regulate size and scope of mega mergers not in the public interest, not make it happen! It was supposed to enhance free speech, free press, etc., not diminish it as it keeps doing. But as global money overran both political parties this was all thrown to the wayside until today six, only six major media companies control 90% of the programming Americans see. And its just that, programming. Programming us all to NOT see problems until their made up bubble burst on us all, or simple solutions, and to keep us all living in numb sleep producing coma we call daily life as our country heads for an economic and social cliff that could end our way of life we call America. That last passage feels like I'm channeling Edward R. Murrow! But that's how we got to Fake News 24/7 from 1,000 TV stations and 1 million Internet stations.
